Purpose:

To create awareness on Work Place Based Assessment (WPBA), particularly, Mini-CEX, among clinicians, examiners and trainees.

Why/Reason:

With the current changes to both undergraduate and Postgraduate (Residency) training, Work Place Based Assessment (WPBA) will be one of the main stay assessment modalities of assessing students' and trainees' performance and their preparedness for future clinical practice. Clinical supervisors, consultants and other grades of health professionals will be directly or indirectly involved in using WPBA in their practice settings to assess, evaluate the work performances and give feedback to trainees as well as their peers. With the introduction of WPBA, the concepts and constructs of assessing trainees have changed. It is therefore, important to understand and apply these constructs when one uses WPBA in clinical learning environment.

Learning Outcomes:

- Recognise the WPBA use in relation to the overall assessment of medical students and trainees.
- Recognise the contemporary best practices of WPBA that ensure good "utility-value" in assessment.
- Apply WPBA tool (Mini-CEX) in an educational setting.
- Identify and overcome challenges faced when implementing WPBA.
